## LIBERTY INCORPORATES METAL BUILDING SYSTEM WITH ARCHITECTURAL ELEMENTS

Simply Self Storage, built by Olathe, a Kansas-based Strickland Construction Company, is a five building self-storage facility. Two of the buildings are single-story units, and the three larger buildings are partially climate controlled.

Recently, the Liberty self-storage group was faced with a new and challenging project in Kansas City, Kan. In addition to the metal building design, the building owner wanted to incorporate some architectural elements in the project. Liberty designed all of the buildings to include split-faced block on the end walls facing an access road. In addition, the two single-story outer buildings showcase a 7":12" roof pitch with a blue architectural standing seam roof. The self-storage project was one of the first to feature a standing seam roof on the climate-controlled buildings and pre-cut embossed mullions and headers.
